FAIRTRADE FORTNIGHT 22ND FEBRUARY TO 7TH MARCH 2021

This year Fairtrade Fortnight will feel very different to that which we have become used to. The COVID-19 pandemic has shown us more than ever how interconnected we are globally. This interconnection is at the very heart of the Fairtrade message this fortnight and is where our role begins. You can be part of the Fairtrade movement and

you have the power to drive long-term change, not only with your shopping choices but also with your support in spreading the message.

One of the main messages for Fairtrade Fortnight 2021 is to highlight the growing challenges that climate change brings to farmers and workers in the communities Fairtrade works with. The facts are straightforward. Farmers and workers in countries such as Kenya, Ethiopia and Honduras, who have done the least to contribute to climate change, are disproportionately affected by it. Fairtrade works to raise the voices of farmers and workers and prioritise what they need to respond to the environmental crises unfolding in already vulnerable communities.
