GENERAL NOTICES

PUBLIC WORSHIP IN THE THEYDON PARISHES

All Saints TG reopens for public worship this week, with a service of Holy Communion at 8.00am; there will be no 9.15am service. St Mary's ST, St Michael's TM and St Mary's TB remain closed for public worship until Sunday 28th March. Holy Communion will be celebrated weekly in All Saints TG on Tuesdays at 10.00am from now on. Services will continue to be conducted in accordance with government and Church of England guidelines. Unfortunately, there will not be congregational singing at this time, and Holy Communion will be offered in one kind (ie bread only) following physical distancing as was the case at the end of 2020. Face coverings should continue to be worn inside the church buildings, and please refrain from coming to a service in person if you have any symptoms of COVID-19.

Subject to the continuing lifting of restrictions, Bishop Peter will be visiting the Benefice on Sunday 30th May, for our joint Benefice service, and there will be the opportunity to be confirmed. Confirmation is a special service where those who were baptised as children have the opportunity to affirm belief in Jesus Christ for themselves, and traditionally it was the custom to receive Holy Communion afterwards. PRAYER LINES

In the Bible, in Proverbs 13.23 we read: "A poor person's farm may produce much food, but injustice sweeps it all away."
